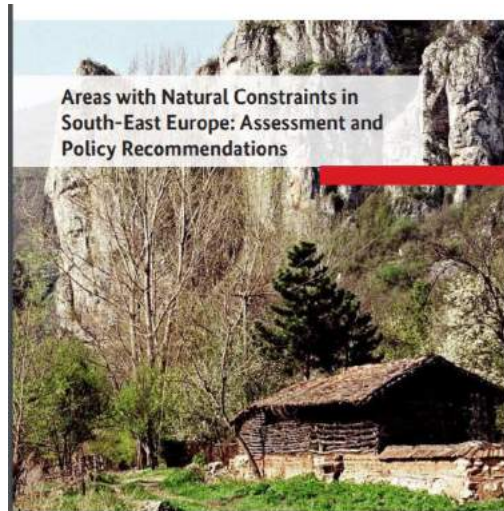

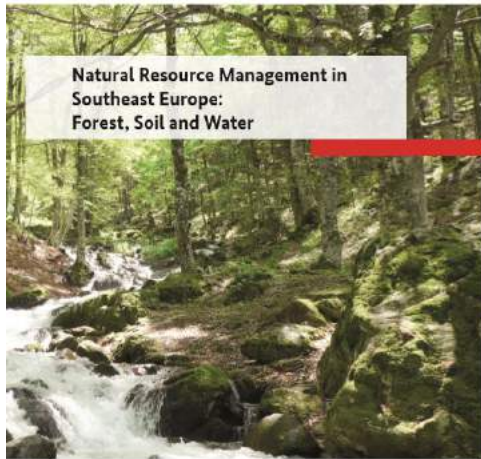

# Summary of the policy recommendations

- Build up new **value creation** opportunities
- Improve and harmonize **spatial planning**
- **Clean** contaminated sites
- Create **cross-sectoral platforms** for policy- and decision-making
- Investigate new avenues for marketing and payment for **ecosystem services**
- Improve **law enforcement** and legal security
- Create a **business-stimulating** environment
- Support the organization of **private land owners**
- Develop clear actions plans in response to **climate change**
- Foster integrated, inter-communicating **monitoring systems** for forest, soil, and water
- Foster **investment** in water infrastructure and strategies for a higher efficiency of water use
- Build **professional capacities** in administration and institutions
- Secure national funding for **education** and capacity building in integrated natural resource management
